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### **First Quarter**

Announcement: January 25<sup>th</sup>

### **Second Quarter**

Time Period: January 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>  
Nominations Due: April 1<sup>st</sup>  
Announcement: April 8<sup>th</sup>

### **Third Quarter**

Time Period: April 1<sup>st</sup> – June 30<sup>th</sup>  
Nominations Due: July 1<sup>st</sup>  
Announcement: July 8<sup>th</sup>

### **Fourth Quarter**

Time Period: July 1<sup>st</sup> – September 30<sup>th</sup>  
Nominations Due: October 1<sup>st</sup>  
Announcement: October 8<sup>th</sup>

You must write in to nominate a coach that you feel has made a difference to an athlete, a peer coach, a club etc. A nominee must meet the minimum requirements of a current Synchro Alberta member and meet the minimum certification requirements as outlined in the Coach Certification Policy.

Once the nominations have been submitted to Synchro Alberta a nominating committee will select one coach to hold the title of coach of the quarter. The nominating committee consists of the Technical Director (Jaime Thompson), the Technical Coordinator (Jennifer Flowers), Synchro Alberta's Coach Representative (Kim Phillips Langer), and one non-synchro member (Mandi Smith).

The Coach of the Quarter will get recognition on the Synchro Alberta web site, and receive a certificate from Synchro Alberta. Additionally all coaches that have been nominated for the quarter will be part of the nominees for the DIVA (Dedication Innovative Valuable Achievement) award that is handed out at the Synchro Alberta Awards Banquet annually.
